Sprinkles Sushi

Ingredients:

- 1 tbsp sprinkles

Chia Seed Sushi

- 1 banana
- 2 squares of milk chocolate or dark chocolate
- 1/2 tbsp chia seeds

Instructions

- 1. Peel the bananas and place them on a plate.
- 2. Melt the chocolate and pour on bananas.
- 3. Put on the chia seeds and sprinkles.
- 4. Put them in the fridge until the chocolate hardens
- 5. Slice and serve

Ingredients:

Rice Krispie Sushi
